



## Frequently Asked Questions about Friday Nights Out

### **Who is allowed to attend Friday Nights Out?**

All currently enrolled Kids' Corner students are allowed to attend. This includes all 3 o'clock Kindergarteners.

### **My child doesn't attend Kids' Corner on Fridays. Is he/she still eligible to attend?**

Yes! Once you have registered for Friday Nights Out, you can drop your child off at Kids' Corner between 6pm and 6:15pm.

### **My child normally attends on Fridays, but I need to pick him/her up early on this specific Friday. May I bring her/him back to attend Friday Nights Out?**

Yes! If your child is registered for Friday Nights Out, you may bring them back between 6pm and 6:15pm.

### **Do I need to provide dinner for my child for a Friday Nights Out?**

No, we provide the meal. Students have the option to help the teachers prepare dinner for everyone attending Friday Nights Out. If your child does not like what we are preparing, you may pack or drop off dinner for them.

### **My child has food allergies. Is the dinner and dessert provided safe for my child to eat?**

Of course. The ingredients in all meals and snacks provided by Kids' Corner are carefully checked for allergens. Feel free to speak to the staff working that Friday Nights Out about any requests or concerns.

### **What will my child be doing during a Friday Nights Out program?**

A typical Friday Nights Out schedule looks like this:

6:00-6:15 Gathering in the K-1 Room

6:15-7:00 Dinner Preparation (optional) and quiet activities/gym time/outside time

7:00-7:30 Family Style Dinner and Dessert

7:30-8:45 Planned Activity or Movie Viewing

8:45-9:00 Quiet games during parent pick-up

### **What is the deadline for registering my child for Friday Nights Out?**

The deadline for Friday Nights Out registration is the **WEDNESDAY** before the program. Please make sure to register on time so we can prepare accordingly.

### **Can siblings/friends who do not attend Kids' Corner come to the program?**

Yes, but only on nights that are designated as **Sibling Nights** or **Bring a Friend Nights**. All siblings/friends must be toilet trained in order to come on those designated nights and we must have an emergency card on file.
